Probate

Trusts

The trick of the trust is in the way it delivers that value; this may be money or property such as a house, shares, etc. A well-designed trust will protect the assets on their journey, possibly making them more tax-efficient.

This will give the trustees (the people in charge of the trust) the flexibility to use the assets to the best advantage of the people the trust is designed to benefit. Whilst the principle of a trust is simple, the law surrounding trusts is complex and requires expertise. Wills

Everyone should make a Will. In the absence of this simple document the relatives and loved ones of a person who dies can face all kinds of difficulties and heartache that could be avoided.

Dying without a Will means the deceased is intestate. Put simply, this means that all of the deceased's assets will be divided up in a completely arbitrary way by a set of rules laid down by statute.

For the sake of practicality and certainty these rules necessarily ignore the nuances of the deceased's life - who they loved or loathed, who they would want to benefit or not.

Making a Will is therefore one of the most thoughtful acts anyone can do.

Firstly, you need to make sure your Will is properly set out and signed so that it is valid (and the rules are strict).
